SQF-MILOF is designed to help Member States develop and classify military qualifications by describing specific learning outcomes for the military officer profession. As such, it serves as an interface or 'translation tool' among the education and training opportunities offered in different countries, making it possible to compare different programmes. By simplifying the identification of equivalent training in other countries, it facilitates professional education and training exchanges between the MS and enhances the creation of a common peace, security, and defence culture.

Administrative Instructions

• The EU Member States and European institutions are invited to nominate two participants each, at mid- to senior-level rank. The training audience includes, but is not limited to, personnel dealing with military qualifications at national level and curriculum developers from training and education providers.

• Applications are to be filled out by the national ENLIST nominators via the ESDC secured registration system <u>https://esdc.europa.eu/enlist/login</u>no later than 20March 2024. A list with relevant ENLIST nominators can be retrieved from the ESDC website at <u>https://esdc.europa.eu/nominators/</u>.

• The course consists of a preliminary part on the eLearning platform of the ESDC and a residential part. Both parts are compulsory. The preliminary session will be available with effect from 20 March 2024. The topics during the residential module will be explored in an interactive manner, in sessions followed by Q&A, as well as in panel discussions and teamwork activities. • The residential module, of the course, is hosted on the NMU premises, 76, Bulgaria blvd., 5007, Veliko Tarnovo, Bulgaria.

• All costs for international travel, transportation to Bulgaria, accommodation and catering during the course are to be covered by the sending authorities. Participants should arrange their own travel to Bulgaria, accommodation, and meals. The closest airports to Veliko Tarnovo are Sofia and Varna.

• Please note that Vasil Levski National Military University will provide transportation from/to Sofia or Varna airports. Transportation will be provided in groups depending on the time of arrival/departure based on the transportation request made in advance.

• Another option for transportation from/to Sofia/Varna airports is to rent a car at the airport or use public transportation (please note that this trip from Sofia/Varna to Veliko Tarnovo may take 3-4 hours). The cost of public transport or a taxi from Sofia/Varna Airport to Sofia/Varna Central Bus Station will be around 10 euros. There is a metro in Sofia, but not in Varna. Bus fare from Sofia/Varna to Veliko Tarnovo is around 20 EUR.

• The dress code is "daily office uniform" for military and "business casual" (jacket with tie or female equivalent) for civilians.

• Please do not book flights and accommodation before receiving the confirmation.

• In case of medical emergencies, costs are to be covered by the participant's medical insurance provided by the sending country / organisation. The organiser does not provide health or accident insurance for participants.
