**Invitation to the
5th BASIC COURSE ON SECURITY SECTOR REFORM
Turin, Italy, 27th - 30th September 2022**

The Italian Army Post Conflict Operations Study Centre, under the auspices of the European Security and Defense College (ESDC), is pleased to organize the "5th Basic Course on Security Sector Reform", which will be held in Turin (ITALY) from 27th to 30th September 2022.

The Course is conceived within the framework of the ESDC education and training annual programme as one of the three educational paths that ESDC has established in response to a specific training need of enhancing SSR knowledge and practice within the European Union.

The aim of the course is to give a general overview and to offer a basic knowledge of the Security Sector Reform (SSR) Concept as an essential multidimensional element of conflict prevention, crisis management, institution building and stabilization effort, which is increasingly playing a central role for a sustainable long-lasting peace. During the course particular attention will be given to the European Union approach and its wide-strategic framework in support of SSR and special emphasis will be given to the Defense Sector Reform (DSR) and its implementing challenges.

The course will consist of two compulsory phases: an Internet-based Distance Learning (IDL) phase (from 1st July to 26th September 2022), followed by a residential phase which will be held in Turin from 27th to 30th September 2022. Should any possible negative evolutions of COVID-19 pandemic happen, the latter phase will be delivered on-line (detailed instructions will be further distributed accordingly). Upon completion of the course participants will acquire a sound understanding of SSR concept being able to apply key EU SSR policy and guidance documents during the planning and/or implementation of a CSDP mission/operation or EU Commission's programmes/projects.

The Italian Army Post Conflict Operations Study Centre (PCOSC), under the aegis of the European Security and Defense College (ESDC), hereby has the pleasure to kindly invite you to nominate your candidates for the 5th Basic Course on SSR which is tailored to military officers (from Major to Colonel) and civilian officials/executive roles, coming from EU MS, Bodies and Agencies (personnel coming from EU candidate Countries can be admitted upon request).

LOG/ADMIN DETAILS

1. In accordance with the ESDC policy, the course has no tuition fees.
2. The costs for travel, accommodation and meals shall be covered by sending authorities.
3. EU MS, EU Institutions and relevant agencies are invited to nominate their candidates and send their applications (via ESDC secure internet ENLIST system) by designated nominators at <https://esdc.europa.eu/enlist/login> .
4. Other invited parties are expected to send their candidates (full name and e-mail address) to the ESDC Secretariat (secretariat-esdc@eeas.europa.eu).
5. **The registration procedure will be open until 27th June 2022.**
6. The final admission to the course is subject to the official confirmation by the ESDC Secretariat and upon completion of the registration form by the nominated participant.
7. The course will consist of the following two mandatory phases:
 - Internet-based Distance Learning (IDL) Phase :
It will take place from 1st July to 27 September 2021. During this phase participants will be required to complete the following Autonomous Knowledge Units (AKUs):
 - ✓ *AKU 2 - The European Security Strategy (ESS)*;
 - ✓ *AKU 3 - Role of EU institutions in the field of CFSP/CSDP*;
 - ✓ *AKU 6 EU decision shaping/making*;
 - ✓ *AKU 11A Gender and the UNSCR 1325*.
 - Residential phase
It will take place from 1st July to 26th September 2022 in Turin at the ITA Army Post Conflict Operations Study Centre – PCOSC (Via Confienza, 16 – 10121 Torino). This phase will consist of frontal lessons and panel discussions in which participants will be encouraged to interact as much as possible.
Should any possible negative evolutions of COVID-19 pandemic happen, the residential phase will be delivered on-line (detailed instructions will be further distributed accordingly).
8. English will be the working language for the course entirety.
9. Attendance is mandatory all days. A certificate will be awarded to those participants who will have completed the full course (including the IDL phase).
10. An ice-breaker social event will be organized during the residential phase.
11. Upon completion of the registration period, a detailed info-package will be forwarded to all the admitted participants.
