

Administrative Instructions

- **Target Group:** The course is open to both civilian and military personnel/law enforcement personnel from EU Member States and EU institutions and agencies.
- **Seats and nominations:** The total number of participants is limited to 30 persons. Typically, one seat /Member State will be allocated. However, depending on the total number of requests, one additional seat could be allocated. EU Member States, EU institutions/agencies are invited to nominate each, two participants maximum.
- **Applications:** Applications from the EU Member States and EU institutions and agencies are to be filed via the ESDC secure internet system ENLIST, by designated nominators, under <https://esdc.europa.eu/enlist/login> no later than **22 September 2025**. A list with relevant ENLIST nominators can be retrieved from the ESDC website at <https://esdc.europa.eu/nominators/>. Registration will not be final until confirmed by the ESDC Secretariat and upon completion of the requested personal data in ENLIST by the confirmed participants.
- **Language:** The language regime of the CSDP – English without translation – applies.
- **Attendance:** The participants' attendance during the course is mandatory on all days. A certificate will be awarded on the last day to those course participants who have completed the full course, including the e-Learning modules.
- **Residential part of the course** will take place at the MPSOTC's premises in Kilkis, from **20 to 24 October 2025 (08:00-14:00)**.
- **E-Learning:** The course will be preceded by a mandatory e-Learning module (AKU) (set to start from **22 September 2025** on the ESDC eLearning platform ILIAS), which needs to be finalised before the residential phase (**Monday 20 October 2025**), in Kilkis begins.
- **Costs:** All costs for travelling, accommodation and catering (including breakfast) during the residential part of the course will be covered by the sending authorities.
- **Dress code:** During the course, smart/business casual for civilians and service uniform (BDU) for military and law enforcement personnel. Smart casual for the social event.
- **Liabilities and Insurance:** In case of medical emergencies, the costs should be covered by the participant's medical insurance provided by the sending country / organisations. The

organiser does not provide health or accident insurances for participants taking part in the event.

- **Registration is not final until confirmed by ESDC Secretariat. Please do not book flights and accommodation before receiving the confirmatory message.**
