- 6. The final admission to the course is subject to the official confirmation by the ESDC Secretariat who will send an official e-mail for the registration on ILIAS platform.
- 7. The course will be run upon reaching the minimum number of 15 participants.
- 8. A specific **joining form** and a subsequent detailed **info-package** (to describe PCOSC premises and its access procedures) will be sent to all the admitted participants once registered on ILIAS.
- 9. The course will consist of the following two mandatory phases:
 - Internet-based Distance Learning (IDL) Phase:

It will take place 15-29 September 2025. During this phase participants will be required to complete the following Autonomous Knowledge Units (AKUs):

- ✓ AKU 11A Gender and the UNSCR 1325 women, peace and security agenda.
- Residential phase

Upon completion of the IDL phase, participants will be admitted to attend the residential phase which will take place from 30 September to 3 October 2025 in Turin at the *Italian Army Post Conflict Operations Study Centre* - PCOSC (Via Confienza, 16 – 10121 Torino). This phase will consist of frontal lessons and panel discussions during which participants will be encouraged to interact one each other and with the lecturers as much as possible.

- 10. English will be the working language during the course. Attendance is mandatory all days. Those participants who will have successfully completed the full course will be awarded with a certificate.
