Registration and deadline: <u>The registration period will end on 17 May 2024</u>. Registrations will not be final until they have been confirmed by the ESDC Secretariat AND the ENLIST registration form has been completed by the nominated participant. Each nominator is kindly requested to nominate participants in order of priority. Further course information will be send to confirmed participants.

Language: The working language will be English, without translation.

E-learning: The course will be preceded by a mandatory e-learning module, which needs to be completed before the residential phase starts.

Attendance: Participants' attendance is mandatory on every day of the course. A certificate will be awarded on the last day to course participants who have completed the full course, including the e-learning modules.

Costs: There is no course fee. All costs related to participants' travel, accommodation and meals must be covered by the sending authorities.
