Administrative Information for the CSDP Orientation Course (Training Activity Number 24-25/3/1) 07–11 October 2024, Lisbon, Portugal

Target group: the course is open to both civilian and military personnel from EU Member States, relevant EU bodies, CSDP Missions and Operations, as well as international organisations, who are either involved in or designated to work on Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP) matters. Third countries and international organisations are welcome to put forward candidates. We are seeking to put together a balanced group composed of diplomats, civilians, police and military personnel.

Seats & nominations: a maximum of 40 participants is envisaged. Typically, one seat per Member State / Institution will be allocated. However, due to the capacity of the classroom, it is not possible to offer more seats than the aforementioned 40 seats.

Application: applications from the EU Member States and EU bodies are to be filed via the ESDC secure internet system ENLIST, by designated nominators, under https://esdc.europa.eu/enlist/login, no later than 02 September 2024. A list of ENLIST nominators can be retrieved from the ESDC website at <u>https://esdc.europa.eu/nominators/</u>.

Applications from third countries and international organisations should be sent to the ESDC Training Manager <u>Christoforos.Christoforou@eeas.europa.eu</u>, by the institution/ organisation that receives this invitation. The application should indicate: the full name of the candidate (as in official documents used for accessing course venue), personal e-mail address (functional mailboxes will not be accepted), nationality, passport number, the validity of the passport, date of birth, institution, reason why this course benefits the applicant.

Registration will not be final until confirmed by the ESDC Secretariat **AND** upon completion of the registration form by the nominated participant.

Attendance: participants' attendance during the course is mandatory on all days. Participants who have completed the full course, including the e-learning modules, will receive a certificate.

E-learning: the course consists of an eLearning part to be completed on the ESDC eLearning platform ILIAS before the course starts (07 October 2024). Connection details will be provided in due time to all registered participants.

Language: the working language is English, without translation.

Gender equality: the ESDC strives for an inclusive environment in all its courses, activities and day-to-day work. Only in an inclusive environment can all people, and therefore the ESDC and its partners, reach their true potential. We do not and will not discriminate based on race, colour, religion, gender, gender expression, age, national origin, disability or sexual orientation in any of our activities or operations. Costs: sending authorities will cover all costs for international travelling and accommodation including meals for all the course participants.

The organiser does not provide health or accident insurance. The National Defence Institute will have the military hospital on call between the 7th and 11th October.

Start and end of activity: the activity will start on Monday, 7 October 08.45hrs and end on Friday, 11 October, 14.00hrs. Please make your travel arrangements accordingly. The programme will be communicated in due course.
