The number or seats to different entities is as follows: EU member states up to 30, BiH sponsored countries (Albania, Croatia, Montenegro, North Macedonia and Serbia) **one** per country, Bosnia and Herzegovina up to 10 (MoD BiH - 2, MFA BiH - 2, MS BiH - 2, AF BiH - 4).
