INVITATION

The European Union Military Staff and the European Security and Defence College have the honour to co-organise the Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP) Orientation Course, held in Brussels, from 6 to 10 November 2023.

The CSDP Orientation Course is a major component of EU training activities in the field of the Common Security and Defence Policy. It aims to develop and promote a better understanding of CSDP as an integral part of the Common Foreign and Security Policy (CFSP) of the European Union. The course will provide participants with an overview of the civilian and military aspects of European Security and Defence Policy and go into more detail as it unfolds.

The course consists of an eLearning part, as well as a residential session, held in Brussels, both parts being compulsory. It will offer an in-depth analysis of Common European Security and Defence Policy, while the participants will have the opportunity to network, and share views and perspectives with one another and with professionals in the field of CSDP.

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Administrative Information

- Target group: The course is open to both civilian and military personnel from EU Member States, relevant EU institutions and Agencies, CSDP Missions and Operations and International Organizations, who are either involved in or designated to work on Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP) matters. Third countries and international organisations are welcome to put forward candidates.
- Seats & nominations: The course capacity is 60 seats, with up to 30 participants from the EU (Force and Operation) Headquarters/Military Planning and Conduct Capability (EU Force / Operation HQ / MPCC Community).
- Application: Applications from the EU Member States, EU institutions and agencies are to be filed via the ESDC secure internet system ENLIST, by designated nominators, under https://esdc.europa.eu/enlist/login, no later than 15 September 2023. A list with relevant retrieved **ESDC** website **ENLIST** nominators can be from the at https://esdc.europa.eu/nominators/. Registration will not be final until confirmed by the ESDC Secretariat AND upon completion of the registration by the nominated participant. Further detailed information on the course will be sent by email to the course participants as soon as the participants list is complete.
- Applications from the EU Force / Operation HQ / MPCC Community should be sent to the EU Operations Centre at <u>eu operations centre@eeas.europa.eu</u> which will make the final selection for the 30 seats dedicated to the EU Force / Operation HQ / MPCC Community. The application should indicate the full name of the candidate (as in official documents used for accessing the course venue), first name, personal e-mail address, nationality, passport number, the validity of passport, date of birth, institution / EU Force / Operation HQ and position in their respective HQ.
- Applications from third countries and international organisations should be sent to the ESDC
 Secretariat at SECRETARIAT-ESDC@eeas.europa.eu by the institution/ organisation that





receives this invitation. The application should indicate: the full name of the candidate (as in official documents used for accessing the course venue), personal e-mail address (functional mailboxes will not be accepted), nationality, passport number, validity of passport, date of birth, institution.

- Attendance: The attendance is mandatory on all days. A certificate will be awarded on the last day to course participants who have completed the full course, including the mandatory e-learning modules.
- **E-Learning:** The course will be preceded by a mandatory e-Learning module (set to start on the 6 October), which should be finalised before the residential phase in Brussels.
- Language: The working language is English without translation.
- Costs: All costs for international travelling and accommodation shall be covered by the sending authorities.
- Venue: The venue will be in the proximity of the Schuman European Quarter, which is where the main EU institutions are located. More precise details will be given later.
- Dress code: Business casual.
- Liabilities and Insurance: In case of medical emergencies, the costs should be covered by the participant's medical insurance provided by the sending country/organization. The organizer does not provide health or accident insurance for participants taking part in the event.
