Annex A: Administrative instructions

1. **Participation:** The course is open to both civilian and military personnel, who are either involved in, or designated to work on Cyber Security and Critical Infrastructure Protection matters. The course is targeted at IT Civil / Military staff who wants to have an essential understanding and practical tools to perform actions to successfully mitigate the most common threats in order to better support their Organization's mission. EU Member States, EU Institutions / Agencies / Bodies (including Missions and Operations), as well as Non EU Entities may nominate candidates for the **28 available seats** in the course.

2. **Language:** The language regime of the course will be **English**.

3. **Attendance:** The participant's attendance at the course is mandatory on all days. A certificate will be awarded on the last day to those course participants who have completed the full course.

4. **Costs:** All costs for travelling, accommodation and dinners shall be covered by the sending authorities. The participants will not pay any fee to participate at the course.

5. **Application:**

EU Member States, EU Institutions, Bodies and Agencies are invited to identify their appropriate candidates. Applications should be submitted via designated nominators using the ESDC's new ENLIST platform, under <https://esdc.europa.eu/enlist/login>,

NATO nations and NATO bodies are invited to provide a list of candidates in order of their respective priority (Priority, first name, last name, email address) to the NMIOTC student admin office STUDENTADMIN@NMIOTC.NATO.INT functional mailbox (with the responsible NMIOTC Course Director Cdr Dimitrios Megas GRC(N) (megasd@nmiotc.nato.int) in CC:). NMIOTC will subsequently transmit a consolidated list to ESDC. NATO nominees will then be considered and invited in accordance with regular ESDC nomination procedures:

- a. Collection of prioritized candidate lists.
- b. One or multiple invitation rounds, prompting the highest-priority candidates of above lists to either confirm or disconfirm their participation until a specified confirmation deadline.
- c. Confirmed candidates are thereafter considered participants. Please note that the number of accepted participants of any given MS/Nation/Organisation therefore logically depends on the number of entities nominating candidates.

The **registration / nomination** period will end on **04 July 2022**. The registration will not be final until confirmed by the ESDC Secretariat (Cyber ETEE team) AND upon completion of the ENLIST registration form by the nominated participant.

6. **Location:** NMIOTC is located on the Akrotiri peninsula near the city of Chania in the north-western part of Crete. The destination airport is Chania International Airport (“Ioannis Daskalogiannis” Airport) (airport code: CHQ). Distance from the city of Chania to NMIOTC is 20 km and from the airport to NMIOTC is 9 km. The following map provides orientation and general driving directions from the city of Chania to NMIOTC.



7. **Dress Code:** Participants are advised to wear smart casual attire for the whole training as well as for the Graduation Ceremony.

8. **Meals:** All lunches will be provided by the NMIOTC. On the first evening, there will be an ice breaker offered by the NMIOTC.

9. **Accommodation:** Participants are responsible to arrange their own accommodation as there is no accommodation facilities on the Centre’s premises. NMIOTC can provide guidance / assistance, if requested. Hotels near Chania city centre are highly recommended for transportation purposes. 10. **Arrival and Departure:** Participants should plan to fly to Chania International airport (airport code: CHQ) and are responsible for their own transportation from / to the Airport during arrival / departure. 11. **Transportation:** Transportation will be provided on a daily basis from Chania city centre pick-up points (Akali, Samaria, Kydon, Kriti and Royal Sun at Acrotiriou st.) to NMIOTC during the course.

12. **Medical service:** Trainees are required to have a valid health insurance according to their respective national standards. Trainees from the EU Member States are required to possess a valid European Health Insurance Card. NMIOTC ensures first aid during training, providing emergency transportation to the Naval Hospital of Crete if needed. The Naval Hospital of Crete will provide diagnosis, first aid and treatment and transfer to Prefectural Hospital of Chania for further diagnosis or specialist treatment if required. NMIOTC is not covering trainees' expenses for additional medical treatments and the settlement of medical bills is a patient/national responsibility.

13. **COVID 19 awareness:** Please take under consideration that due to the current COVID-19 situation and the undertaken preventive and protective measures, the conduct of the course is considered, feasible. Furthermore NMIOTC is ready to welcome participants to NMIOTC's events according to the new travel rules as described in details in the governmental site <https://travel.gov.gr/#/> (protocol for arrivals in Greece).

Note: It is advised the participants to take into account any further travel restrictions and rules from intermediate countries that they will travel through.
