Administrative Information

- **Target group:** The course is open to both civilian and military personnel from EU Member States, relevant EU institutions and Agencies, CSDP Missions and Operations and International Organizations, who are either involved in or designated to work on Common Security and Defence Policy (CSDP) matters. Third countries and international organisations are welcome to put forward suitable candidates.
- Seats & nominations: The course capacity is 60 seats, with up to 30 participants from the EU (Operational and Forward) Headquarters/Military Planning and Conduct Capability (EU (F)(O) HQ/ MPCC) Community. However, the maximum capacity will be dictated by the rules of social distancing in force at the deadline for applications.
- Application: Applications from the EU Member States, EU Institutions and Agencies are to be filed via the ESDC secure internet system ENLIST, by designated nominators, under https://esdc.europa.eu/enlist/login, no later than 17 March 2023. A list with relevant from ESDC website ENLIST nominators be retrieved the at can https://esdc.europa.eu/nominators/. Registration will not be final until confirmed by the ESDC Secretariat AND upon completion of the registration form by the nominated participant.
- Applications from the EU (F) (O)HQ/ MPCC Community should be sent to the EU Operations Centre at <u>eu operations_centre@eeas.europa.eu</u> which will make the final selection for the 30 seats dedicated to the EU(F) (O) HQ / MPCC Community. The application should indicate the full name of the candidate (as in official documents used for accessing course venue), first name, personal e-mail address, nationality, passport number, the validity of passport, date of birth, institution / EU OHQ and position in the (F) (O)HQ; reason how this course benefits the applicant.
- Applications from third countries and international organisations should be sent to the ESDC Secretariat at <u>SECRETARIAT-ESDC@eeas.europa.eu</u> by the institution/ organisation that receives this invitation. The application should indicate: the full name of the candidate (as in official documents used for accessing course venue), personal e-mail address (functional





mailboxes will not be accepted), nationality, passport number, validity of passport, date of birth, institution; reason how this course benefits the applicant.

- Attendance: The participant's attendance during the course is mandatory on all days. A certificate will be awarded on the last day to those course participants who have completed the full course, including the e-Learning modules.
- E-Learning: The course will be preceded by a mandatory e-Learning module (set to start on the 10th of April), which needs to be finalised before the residential phase in Brussels starts.
- Language: The working language is English without translation.
- **Costs:** All costs for international travelling and accommodation (including breakfast) shall be covered by the sending authorities.
- Dress code: Dress/jacket and tie 24 Apr. Business casual clothes for the rest of the course.
- Liabilities and Insurance: In case of medical emergencies, the costs should be covered by the participant's medical insurance provided by the sending country/organization. The organizer does not provide health or accident insurance for participants taking part in the event.
