# "Integrated Border Management" Course Kilkis, Greece 31 Oct – 04 Nov 2022 (Training Activity Number 22-23/72/1)



## Administrative Instructions

- **Target Group:** The course is open to both civilian and military personnel/ law enforcement personnel from EU Member States and EU Institutions and Agencies.
- **Seats and nominations:** the total number of participants is limited to 30 persons. Typically, one seat /Member State will be allocated. However, depending on the total number of requests, one additional seat could be allocated. EU Member States, EU-Institutions/Agencies, are invited to nominate each, one participant Maximum.
- **Applications:** Applications from the EU Member States, EU Institutions and Agencies are to be filed via the ESDC secure internet system ENLIST, by designated nominators, under <https://esdc.europa.eu/enlist/login> no later than **23th September 2022**. A list with relevant ENLIST nominators can be retrieved from the ESDC website at <https://esdc.europa.eu/nominators/>. Registration will not be final until confirmed by the ESDC Secretariat and upon completion of the requested personal data in ENLIST by the confirmed participants.
- **Language:** The language regime of the CSDP - English without translation - applies.
- **Attendance:** The participant's attendance during the course is mandatory on all days. A certificate will be awarded on the last day to those course participants who have completed the full course, including the e-Learning modules.
- **Residential part of the course** will take place at the MPSOTC's premises in Kilkis, from the **31 October to the 04 November 2022** (Monday 08.00 to Friday 13.00).
- **E-Learning:** The course will be preceded by a mandatory eLearning module (set to start from **03 October 2022** on the ESDC eLearning platform ILIAS), which needs to be finalised before the residential phase (**Monday 31 October 2022**), in Kilkis, Greece starts.
- **Costs:** All costs for travelling, accommodation and catering (including breakfast) during the residential part of the course shall be covered by the sending authorities.
- **Dress code:** dress/jacket and tie or service uniform.
- **Liabilities and Insurance:** in case of medical emergencies, the costs should be covered by the participant's medical insurance provided by the sending country / organisations. The organiser does not provide health or accident insurances for participants taking part in the event.
- Given the current COVID-19 crisis and possible further restrictions imposed for public events in the upcoming months, the organisation of the course in residential format might not be possible. **Therefore the course will be confirmed by 03 October 2022. Please do not book flights and accommodation before receiving the confirmatory message.**
