The Italian Centre for Higher Defence Studies (CASD) has the honour of organising, under the aegis of the European Security and Defence College, the pilot edition of the course on "Cognitive Warfare in the new international competition: an emerging challenge for EU". The course will take place in Rome, Italy, from 21 to 23 May 2023 (in a residential format).

The introductory course aims to raise awareness on the emerging competition in the cognitive dimension with the related risks to resilience and cohesion of EU institutions and societies. All participants should be mid to senior level officials and experts (civilian, including diplomats, police, and military) and will be invited to create a network of personnel working in the field of international competition in the cognitive dimension.

- Cognitive Warfare in the new international competition:

an emerging challenge for EU

(Rome - IT, 21-23.05.2024)-

- Target group: the course is open to civilian, military, as well as police, diplomatic and intelligence
 personnel from EU Member States. The target group is focused on suitable participants with
 expertise in management, leadership, coaching and /or mentoring in security, intelligence and/or
 diplomacy.
- Places and nominations: around 35 places will be available for international participants. Typically, one or two places per EU Member State will be allocated however, depending on the total number of requests, one additional place could be provided. We are seeking to put together a balanced group composed of civilians, police, intelligence, diplomatic, and military personnel.
- Applications should be sent by 01 May, 2024, as follows: Applications from EU Member States must be filed via the ESDC secure internet system ENLIST, by designated nominators, under https://esdc.europa.eu/enlist/login. A list with relevant ENLIST nominators can be found on the ESDC website at https://esdc.europa.eu/nominators/.
- Attendance: participants' attendance on all days of the course is mandatory. A certificate will be
 awarded on the last day to those course participants who have completed the entire course. This
 course will not be offered in a hybrid format.
- Language: the working language is English, without interpretation.
- Costs: sending authorities must cover travel and accommodation costs (including breakfast) for representatives of EU Member States.
- Gender equality: the ESDC strives for a gender-sensitive and inclusive environment in all its courses, activities and day-to-day work.
