In 2019, EDA started the development of a Methodology for Developing Cyber Defence Training Courses and the conduct of several Cyber Defence Pilot Courses under the project 18.CAT.OP.205. The Methodology was delivered at the end of 2019 and is published on the <u>EDA website</u>.

In that context, EDA is pleased to invite pMS, EU Institutions, Bodies and Agencies (including Commands of Missions and Operations) and Switzerland to nominate candidates for attending "**The Contribution of Cyber in Hybrid Conflict**" Course. This course activity is organised by EDA under the aegis of the European Security and Defence College (ESDC) and follows the ESDC rules of nomination and selection for the participants.

The course is announced as ESDC Activity No 24-25/274/1.

The course will take place from **25 to 29 November 2024 at the European Centre of Excellence for Countering Hybrid Threats (HYBRID CoE)** in Helsinki, FI, as a physical course for a maximum of 40 participants. The course starts on 25 November 2024 at 09:30 local time in Helsinki and finishes on Friday 29 November 2024 at 12:00 local time. The course will be held in English.

Course aim

To educate participants about key elements of cyber defence and hybrid threats, and to provide them with the necessary practice of understanding, via a decision-making exercise, in addressing the implications of the intersection of cyber and hybrid threats threats/attacks and campaigns. Additionally, the course will provide

participants with opportunities for networking and intellectual cross-fertilisation, including across communities that may not frequently interact.

<u>Note</u>: The Table-top exercise (TTX) is a decision-making exercise which will engage participants in a multi-turn adversarial contest and in a high-level abstracted synthetic context.

Targeted audience

The course is for **non-specialized and specialized on strategic level** Mid-to-senior rank military officers and civilian officials equivalent **in (or liable for) Cyber / Hybrid-related practitioner roles** in EU Institutions, or in Member State ministries (e.g. MoDs; MoIs; MoFAs), relevant Agencies, or military HQs who:

- Engage in development of policies, strategies, concepts, or doctrine related to cybersecurity, cyber defence, hybrid threats; and/or
- Design or deliver professional education courses, individual training courses, or command post exercises related to cybersecurity, cyber defence, or hybrid threats.

ESDC ADMINISTRATIVE COURSE INSTRUCTIONS

The course will be offered in English from **25 to 29 November 2024** in **fully residential form in Helsinki, Finland**, for a **maximum of 40 participants**, with sufficient accommodation. It is open to professionals **specialized or non-specialized on strategic level:** mid-to-senior rank military officers and civilian officials equivalent **in (or liable for) cyber- or hybrid-related practitioner roles** in EU Institutions, or in Member State ministries (e.g. MoDs; MoIs; MoFAs), relevant Agencies, or military HQs who:

- Engage in development of policies, strategies, concepts, or doctrine related to cybersecurity, cyber defence, hybrid threats; and/or
- Design or deliver professional education courses, individual training courses, or command post exercises related to cybersecurity, cyber defence, or hybrid threats.

Applications from the EU Member States and institutions are to be filled out by the national ENLIST nominators via the ESDC secure registration system via the following link https://esdc.europa.eu/enlist/login, no later than **01 October 2024**. A list of relevant ENLIST nominators can be retrieved from the ESDC website at https://esdc.europa.eu/nominators/.

The course will consist of an **online component** (asynchronous) on the ESDC's e-learning platform and a **live** (*fully residential*) **face to face component**, with both parts being compulsory.

The e-learning component will be available to the selected participants from 08 October 2024. The topics covered during the face-to-face sessions will be explored in an interactive manner in sessions followed by Q&As, panel discussions and group activities.

All international travel, transportation and accommodation costs during the course are to be covered by the sending authorities. It is recommended that participants arrive at Helsinki international airport by Sunday 24 November 2024 at the latest. Participants should arrange their own travel and accommodation. Further information will be sent to participants following registration.

The dress code is business casual for both civilians and military personnel. The format of the course is residential at the **HYBRID Centre of Excellence (HYBRID CoE) Helsinki, Finland**. Please do not book flights and accommodation before receiving the confirmation message. Supporting services:

Transportation from and to airport

The distance from the airport to the city centre of Helsinki is approx. 20 km. Recommended: Airport trains I and P (one-way regional ticket ABC-zone: 4,10 euros)

- This is the best option if you cannot use a taxi. The trains run every 5-10 minutes to the Helsinki Central Railway Station which is about 1 kilometer away from the conference venue.
