CSDP Orientation Course (ESDC Activity Number 23-24/3/19) Madrid, 03-07 June 2024

ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION

- **Venue:** The residential part will be held in Madrid at the National Defence Advanced Studies Centre (CESEDEN), "Paseo de la Castellana", 61, 28071 Madrid.
- **Participation:** The course is open to civilian, police and military personnel from EU Member States, EU Institutions and Agencies. Participants will normally be entry-level or mid-level staff with some previous experience in security policy issues. EU Member States, EU Institutions and Agencies who are interested, are invited to nominate participants. The course welcomes participants from Third Countries, International Organizations, and NGOs, based on the availability of seats.
- **Application:** Applications from EU Member States, EU institutions, and agencies should be submitted through the ESDC secure internet system ENLIST by designated nominators. This can be done at <https://esdc.europa.eu/enlist/login> and must be completed no later than 15 April 2024. A list of relevant ENLIST nominators is available on the ESDC website at <https://esdc.europa.eu/nominators/>. Registration will only be considered final upon confirmation by the ESDC Secretariat and completion of the registration process by the nominated participant. Further detailed information about the course will be sent via email to the participants once the participant list is complete. Applications from third countries and international organisations should be sent to the ESDC training manager at maria.penedos@eeas.europa.eu by the institution/ organisation that receives this invitation. The application must include the following details: the full name of the candidate, personal e-mail address (functional mailboxes will not be accepted), sending institution, nationality, date of birth, passport number and its validity.
- **Attendance:** The attendance is mandatory on all days. A certificate will be awarded on the last day to course participants who have completed the full course, including the mandatory e-learning modules.

- **E-Learning:** The course will be preceded by a mandatory e-Learning module (set to start on the 22 April), which should be finalised before the residential phase in Madrid.
- **Language:** The working language is English without translation.
- **Costs:** The sending authorities shall cover all costs for international travelling and accommodation.
- **Dress code:** Business casual.
- **Liabilities and Insurance:** In case of medical emergencies, the costs should be covered by the participant's medical insurance provided by the sending country/organization. The organizer does not provide health or accident insurance for participants taking part in the event.
