5-10 May 2025, Stockholm, Sweden

The Swedish Civil Contingencies Agency (MSB) and the European Security and Defence College (ESDC) are jointly organising the Mission Medical Security Course (MedSec) from Monday 5 May to Saturday 10 May 2025 in Sweden.

The aim of the course is to provide security and duty of care personnel with knowledge, skills and ability required to prevent and respond to life-threatening emergencies in a safe, secure, timely and effective manner. This will expand the ability to act as first responder in a medical emergency.

The MedSec Course is aimed at personnel selected for, or already working for, a CSDP mission/operation. Upon availability of seats, the course is open for other candidates of Member States.

The ESDC is committed to an inclusive, gender-sensitive and discrimination-free environment. Only in an inclusive environment can all people – and, hence the ESDC and its partners– realise their true potential. We therefore strongly encourage applicants who are more likely to be underrepresented to apply.

Annex 1: Administrative information

Target audience: The course is open to security and duty of care personnel from EU Member States and from CSDP missions/operations.

How to apply: Applications are to be enrolled via the ESDC secure system ENLIST, by designated nominators, under https://esdc.europa.eu/enlist/login, no later than a April 2025. A list with relevant ENLIST nominators can be found on the ESDC website at https://esdc.europa.eu/nominators/.

Registration: Registration will not be final until confirmed by the ESDC Secretariat. When the participants' list is finalised, the course administration will be in contact with selected participants and provide more detailed information on the course.

Late registration: Subject to availability of seats the course is open for late registration, please contact point of contact (details below).

- Start/End: Monday 5 May, 08.00 to Saturday 10 May 15.30. Participants are welcome to arrive to Rosersberg on the 4 May after 15.00, and stay to 11 May 11.00 if needed.
- Seats: A maximum of 20 participants.
- Location: The course will be held residentially in Rosersberg, Stockholm.
- Language: The working language is English, without translation.
- Cost: The sending authorities will cover all travel costs, meals and accommodation. Accommodation and meals will be provided by MSB Training Facility Rosersberg (single room + breakfast) at a cost of €92. (Pre-booked by the Training Institute and paid with bank card upon arrival).





- **E-learning:** Optional e-learning modules will be offered; detailed information will be shared with selected participants.
- Attendance: The participant's attendance during every module is mandatory, with no exceptions. A certificate will be awarded on the last day to the course participants who have successfully completed the course.
- Liability and insurance: In the event of medical emergencies, the participant's medical insurance provided by the sending country/organisation must cover all related costs. The organisers do not provide health or accident insurance for course participants.
