In the framework of the European Security and Defence College, the European Defence Agency and the Austrian Ministry of Defence are pleased to invite delegates to the **two modules** of the **European Armaments Cooperation Course** for **2022**.

The aim of the **European Armament Cooperation (EAC) Course** is to enhance mutual understanding in armament cooperation by critical analysis of the armaments sector; identifying the frameworks, stakeholder's tools and processes, understanding the challenges at stake and benefits at EU level. The Course will deliver commonly educated EAC managers who are able to participate efficiently in international armament cooperation projects, predominantly in the CSDP-context.

The course is aimed at personnel working in related posts to national and international armament cooperation, who need to gain knowledge and experience in multilateral project management and acquisition processes. In addition, the course supports experts, able to perform in future leadership positions in the wider defence area.

The European Armament Co-operation Course is structured in two consecutive modules: a three-day residential Awareness Level Course running over the period 24 - 26 October 2022 at the European Defence Agency (EDA) in Brussels, and a five-day residential Expert Level Course conducted over the period 21 – 25 November 2022 at the Marine Etablissement Amsterdam (MEA) and the Royal Netherlands Navy Base in Den Helder, supported by the Netherlands Ministry of Defence.

The knowledge imparted from the Awareness Level Course forms the basis for the Expert Level Course. Participation in the Expert Level Course is therefore only possible if the Awareness Level Course has been completed first. Additionally, modules of the Internet Distance Learning (IDL) of the ESDC are prerequisites for attending the EAC course.

We are therefore very pleased to invite you to this ESDC training activity in support of the Common Security and Defence Policy. For further information, please refer to the outline curriculum and the administrative details in the annexes.

#### Sending Parties

- The European Armament Co-operation (EAC) Course is open to participants from all EU Member States, participating Member States of the EDA (incl. Norway, Switzerland and Serbia), candidate countries, relevant EU institutions and agencies.
- Participation by course participants from candidate countries is subject to the existence of a **security agreement and an administrative arrangement with EDA** at the time when the course starts.
- For all participants, an EU Security Clearance "*Restraint UE*" is mandatory. This document has to be presented at the first day of the course.

#### Modalities

- The maximum size of the course will be limited to 40 participants.
- The course will be preceded by the European Armament Co-operation Course Awareness Level. The residential part of the course will take place in the Netherlands (Amsterdam and Den Helder) from 21 to 25 November 2022.
- Participant's attendance at the course is mandatory on all days. A certificate of attendance signed by the High Representative of the Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy will be awarded on the last day of the course.
- The completion of the Awareness Level Course is a prerequisite for attending the Expert Level.

#### **Registration of participants**

• EU Member States, EU institutions and relevant agencies are invited to identify their appropriate candidates via the ESDC secure internet system ENLIST by their designated nominators.
