Within the framework of its training of the legal advisers of the Austrian Armed Forces, the Austrian Federal Ministry of Defence (MoD) is organizing, under the auspices of the European Security and Defence College (ESDC), its Course on INTERNATIONAL LAW FOR MILITARY LEGAL ADVISERS.

The intention of the course is to deepen the theoretical and practical knowledge of military legal advisers in the field of international operational law and international humanitarian law. Since its beginning in 2004, the course has been aimed at military lawyers and civilian legal advisers in the Austrian armed forces or the MoD, as well as from Central and South-Eastern Europe. Beginning with its fourth edition, the course has also been open to applicants from other European countries. Since at least 2010, the course has had the privilege of being part of the academic programme of the European Security and Defence College (ESDC).

This year marks the 11<sup>th</sup> edition of the Vienna course on INTERNATIONAL LAW FOR MILITARY LEGAL ADVISERS. Previous participants have praised this Vienna course for its common legal background, its large proportion of practical work and the opportunity to expand the network of legal advisors.
