### ENTRY TO FINLAND FROM ABROAD DURING THE PANDEMIC

We recommend that when you are arriving in Finland, you have a certificate of negative Covid-19 test taken no earlier than 72 hours before arrival or an EU-certificate of a full COVID-19 vaccination.

- Participants are to be fully covered by a valid health insurance; ESDC, Hybrid CoE and Finland do not cover any medical costs, including emergencies and costs for the treatment of SARS COV II infection.

### Transportation from and to airport

The distance from the airport to the city centre of Helsinki is approx. 20 km. There are multiple options for transportation such as local trains, different buses, Finnair City Bus, taxi etc.

*Recommended:* Airport trains I and P (one-way regional ticket ABC-zone: 4,10 euros)

- This is the best option if you cannot use a taxi. The trains run every 5-10 minutes to the Helsinki Central Railway Station which is about 1 kilometer away from the conference venue.
- Travel time: approximately 30 minutes
