The Italian Centre for Higher Defence Studies (CASD) has the honour to organise, under the aegis of the European Security and Defence College (ESDC), the *Sectoral Qualifications Framework for the Military Officer Profession (SQF-MILOF) Familiarisation Course*, in Rome, from 15 May to 17 May 2023.

Designed to help Member States develop and classify military qualifications by describing specific learning outcomes for the military officer profession, SQF-MILOF serves as an interface for the various education and training opportunities offered in different countries and a tool for comparing different programmes. By simplifying the identification of equivalent training carried out in other countries, it facilitates vocational education and training exchanges between the Member States and enhances the creation of a common peace, security and defence culture.

The course aims to familiarise competent personnel from the EU Member States and Institutions with the SQF-MILOF package by discussing the implications of implementation roadmaps at national level and providing the basic skills required to harmonise selected national military qualifications with the SQF-MILOF and with the Core Curriculum for Military Officers (MILOF-CORE).

The successful implementation of the SQF-MILOF requires a broader interaction between a series of national stakeholders; we are therefore very pleased to invite you to nominate appropriate candidates to attend this ESDC training activity. # Sectoral Qualifications Framework for the Military Officer Profession (SQF-MILOF) Familiarisation Course

(Training Activity Number 22-23/65/3)

Hosted by the Centre for Higher Defence Studies (CASD) Rome, 15 - 17 May 2023

- The EU Member States and European institutions are invited to nominate two participants each. The trainees will include, but are not limited to, personnel dealing with military qualifications at national level and curriculum developers from training and education providers.
- Applications are to be filed by designated nominators via the ESDC secure internet system ENLIST, under <a href="https://esdc.europa.eu/enlist/login">https://esdc.europa.eu/enlist/login</a> no later than 14 April 2023. A list with relevant ENLIST nominators can be found on the ESDC website at <a href="https://esdc.europa.eu/nominators/">https://esdc.europa.eu/nominators/</a>.
- Registration will not be final until confirmed by the ESDC Secretariat and upon completion of the requested personal data in ENLIST by the confirmed participants.
- The course language is English.
- The course consists of an e-Learning part done on the ESDC eLearning platform ILIAS, and an in-situ session held in Rome; both parts are compulsory. The eLearning part should be completed before the beginning of the in-situ part. Participants will receive specific instructions in due time.
- Attendance of the course is mandatory on all days. A certificate signed by Mr Josep BORRELL, High Representative of the European Union for Foreign Affairs and Security Policy / Vice-President of the European Commission, will be awarded to participants who have completed the full course, including the eLearning phase.
- The course starts on 20 April 2023 with the eLearning phase. The in-situ part of the course, from 15 to 17 May, is hosted by the Centre for Higher Defence Studies (CASD) (Piazza della Rovere 83, 00165 Rome, entrance gate at Via della Lungara 81), <a href="https://www.difesa.it/SMD\_/CASD/Pagine/Carta-topografica.aspx">https://www.difesa.it/SMD\_/CASD/Pagine/Carta-topografica.aspx</a>;).
- Travel and accommodation arrangements should not be made before the reception of the message confirming the nominee's admission. All costs for international travel, transportation, accommodation and catering during the course will be covered by the sending authorities. Participants should arrange their own travel, accommodation and meals. Transportation will not be provided by the course organisers.
- Please do not book accommodation and travel before receiving the confirmatory message.
- The dress code is 'daily office uniform' for military and 'business casual' (jacket with tie or female equivalent) for civilians, including for the 'family photo'.
- In case of medical emergencies, costs should be covered by participant's medical insurance provided by the sending country / organization. The organizer does not provide health or accident insurance for participants.

### **Arrival**

You can reach Rome by plane through the following airports:

- FIUMICINO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT;
- CIAMPINO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

Upon your <u>arrival at Fiumicino International Airport</u> you can:

1. take the 'Leonardo Express' train to Roma Termini station (cost € 14), take Metro A (direction Battistini station) to Ottaviano station (cost € 1.5) and then walk to the selected hotel.



2. take the shuttle Bus to Via Crescenzio n. 2 (near the Vatican – the fare is 6 €) and then walk to the selected hotel.



3. take a taxi to the hotel. The cost varies depending on the time of day but the standard fare is about € 50.

Upon arrival at Ciampino International Airport you can:

1. take the Shuttle Bus to Roma Termini station (cost € 6), take the metro to Ottaviano station (direction Battistini – cost € 1,5) and walk to the selected hotel;



2. take a taxi from Ciampino Airport to the hotel. The cost varies depending on the time of day but the standard fare is about € 30.

#### <u>Meals</u>

Lunches can be taken at the CASD canteen on a voluntary basis and at the participant's own expense. Participants wishing to have lunch at CASD during the course must book in advance via mail (\*), then buy the tickets on-site on the first day. Lunch will  $cost \in 4.39$  each day and the payment is cash only (please bring the exact amount with you ( $\in 4.39$  x number of meals requested).

### **Cafeteria**

Two cafeterias are available: one is in the CASD courtyard (opposite the conference room) and the other one is at the 'Lungara' Army Club, on the CASD premises.

#### **Icebreaker** event

A hosted Icebreaker for participants and organising staff will be held at the CASD on Monday 15 May 2023 at 17:00 inside the CASD premises. Dress code is 'smart casual' (jacket no tie) or daily uniform.

#### **CASD** safety instructions
