Only applications received in the above mentioned format by **10 February 2025 at 13:00 CET** will be considered for this call for applications.

Division RM.BHR.3 of the EEAS will examine the applications in terms of the required competences and the ESDC will hold selection interviews in February 2025.

Please note that all SNEs posted to the EEAS must have security clearance at least at the level of EU SECRET/SECRET UE.

Please draw the attention of the various relevant ministries and services to the proper treatment of personal data and inform them that the EEAS implements data protection rules in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2018/1725 of the European Parliament and the Council.
